c) "had deliberated on" - Esta forma en pasado perfecto sugiere que la deliberación ocurrió antes de otro evento en el pasado. No hay tal evento en la oración.

d) "would have been deliberating on" - Esta es una forma condicional perfecta continua, y no hay contexto para usarla aquí.



Consejo/Recomendación:

Repasa el presente perfecto continuo en inglés, que se usa para describir acciones que empezaron en el pasado y continúan o se relacionan con el presente.

Razón por la cual las respuestas incorrectas son incorrectas:

a) "having created" - La estructura del gerundio perfecto no es apropiada aquí. Sugeriría que la acción de crear ocurrió antes de imaginar, lo cual no tiene sentido en el contexto.

b) "been creating" - Esta forma verbal no es correcta gramaticalmente en este contexto.

c) "having been creating" - El gerundio perfecto continuo sugiere una acción que ocurrió durante un periodo de tiempo antes de otra acción. No es adecuado aquí.

d) basic: Al igual que "rudimentary", sugiere un nivel elemental de comprensión, lo que contradice la descripción proporcionada.
